How did GEM New Start Centre (NSC) come about?

Embracing the same passion as Ps Lilian and together with a few other ladies to help teens at risk and women-in-need, GEM NSC started 3 years ago when God miraculously placed people, resources and finance together in a short span of our planning. GEM stands for "Graceful, Empowered, Masterpiece" – our vision for each WIN who comes for help.



What were the beginnings of GEM Beauty?

GEM beauty, an extension of GEM NSC, was set up to provide skills development and work training for the girls. The idea for the beauty centre came about after 2 groups of our girls finished the 6 months program and are ready to be employed. Working in GEM Beauty is a step before they actually go in the REAL world to work. We decided to put the girls under our employment in the beauty centre to further train them to manage work stress, attitude, team work and expectation. These girls have finished our program with one going for further skill training with accreditation for her to build a career on Nails SPA and the other helping her family business.

Have you been encouraged during the last 3 years with GEM NSC?

I am very encouraged each time when I shared with my friends about what I am doing and my passion to help these girls. They too realised there is a great need for this work as many teen girls are lost and living in hopelessness. Therefore many of them showed their support in different ways. Witnessing the transformations of the girls is definitely very encouraging.

Moving forward, what are your hopes and aspirations for GEM?

My hope is to provide more areas of help to many out there who need them. As Ps Lilian mentioned, a temporary "Shelter Home". In addition to beauty-related jobs, I hope to expand the job scope at GEM to include other skills such as IT, flower arrangement, sewing and cooking.

INSIDE-OUT GEM BEAUTY Program aims to help girls and women to journey from their destructive past toward a New Start in life.

- This program engages the participant in the attitudinal aspects of life & womanhood, life skills processes, and includes the element of work skills in the Beauty Industry.
- The program offers methods and guidelines that will help the participant identify the challenges of life, help her grasp the principles of self-worth and esteem, and enable her to move forward with positive self-belief, as well as skills for gainful employment.





Sharing from GEM Beauty

I am Jean Marie and have been working in GEM as a beauty trainer for about 3 years.

As I teach the girls outer beauty skills, I also learned a lot about inner beauty skills while working with them. I learned how to handle every girl differently and play various roles (colleague, friend, superior, mother) to them. I learnt to love without expectations and even when I am disappointed. I press on even when I don't feel like loving or even when I feel like giving up.



Watching the girls grow brings satisfaction. And when I see the changes and improvements in them, I learn that when we as human beings run out of ideas, God can do wonders.

Of course there are ups n downs, times when the girls are sweet, times when they are not so teachable, times when they do things that will encourage me, times when they disappoint me.

During those moments, I needed God's love, wisdom n strength. Each time when I need to learn how to love them with God's love, it brings me closer to God because I need to draw strength from him.

I thank God for not giving up on me then, so now I can have the chance to love the girls like how God loves me.

A lesson on gratitude

Before I joined GEM, I was serving my prison sentence. I was selected to attend a beauty course conducted by GEM while serving my time, which was how I got to know what the organisation is all about.

I joined GEM after I was released from prison, and they taught me many life skills, such as character development. I also went through an advanced beauty course to upgrade my skills. GEM taught me how to be humble and the importance of saying "thank you", "sorry" and "please". Because of my pride, these are three words that I hate to say, but yet I am saying them now every day!

Getting a new start

I stopped schooling at the age of 17 because of family problems. It was then that my life changed. My father suggested that my mum, brother and I moved elsewhere, so we turned to a Family Care Centre for help. The centre counsellor found us a place to stay at a shelter for one to two years while my mother applied for a rental flat. After a few months, we finally had our own rental flat. Since I stopped schooling, I just stayed at home, doing nothing except eating, sleeping and watching television. It was the same routine daily.

I joined GEM in mid-December 2013 through the counsellor too. GEM helps me to build my self-confidence through their character development program at the New Start Centre. I have learnt about the importance of self-confidence, good work attitudes and punctuality. I have also made more friends through GEM. I have also learnt a work skill on manicure and pedicure which I enjoy very much. Above all, I learnt about God and that He loves me dearly. I have since then believed and accepted Him into my life. GEM has a career path for me and I foresee that I will become a professional manicurist in the future and have my own shop.
